2020 LEGISLATIVE YOUTH TOUR



Steuben Rural Electric Cooperative is looking for an 11th grade student to sponsor for the Annual National Rural Electric Cooperative Association Legislative Conference in April.

The 2020 Legislative Youth Tour is sponsored by the Steuben Rural Electric Cooperative and is available to students who reside in a home serviced by the Cooperative. Qualified students who apply have the opportunity to participate in a exciting, allexpense-paid trip to Washington D.C. from April 26 - April 29, 2020.

The selected student will join representatives from Steuben Rural Electric Cooperative in meetings on Capitol Hill with members of Congress as part of the annual National Rural Electric Cooperative Association (NRECA) Legislative Conference. The conference is a national lobbying effort by our nation's rural electric Cooperatives to inform

our Members of Congress about rural areas like those in Steuben, Schuyler, Cattaraugus and Chautauqua counties. This is an excellent learning opportunity for students. He or she will gain first-hand experience in how our national government works.

Students will also have the chance to enjoy a tour of Washington D.C. with other student representatives from New York State electric cooperatives. This opportunity is an all-expense-paid trip except for general spending money that the student may elect to spend on souvenirs and incidentals. The student delegates have attended major league baseball games, theatre shows and more in the past.

In order to be considered

students must meet the following qualifications: Be in their junior (11th grade) year; Be a son/daughter of a member of the Steuben Rural Electric Cooperative; Have at least a "B" average or better; Participate in extra-curricular activities and community service.

Students interested in being considered for this event must complete an application and have it submitted to the Bath District office of Steuben Rural Electric Cooperative by 4pm on March 17, 2020. Operations Update



As mentioned in the previous edition of The Energizer, the Cooperative has ambitious system maintenance goals for 2020. Most significantly, the Cooperative is planning to rebuild nearly 6 miles of subtransmission line to our Quarry substation, which feeds Bath, Howard and Cameron. In addition to this rebuild, the Cooperative will also be reconductoring parts of its system on County Route 10 in Bath and Cameron, along with the installation of additional sectionalizing devices. These projects are expected to begin in the spring and are anticipated to last for several months. As spring is rapidly approaching, our Integrated Vegetation Management (IVM) program is gearing up for another season. Clearing will be occurring in our Bath District in the Towns of Hornell, Howard, Bath and Cameron. In our Cherry Creek District, clearing will be focused in the Towns of New Albion, Leon and Napoli. We continue to see significant improvements in

reliability from our IVM program and encourage any members interested in learning more about our program to visit: http://www.steubenrec. coop/content/right-way-management.

In addition to the 2020 goals and objectives, the Cooperative is also pleased to report that we recently closed on a sale of the Cooperative's landfill gas to energy plant to Steuben County. This sale was effective on January 17th, 2020. Proceeds from the sale of the facility will be utilized to repay existing debt obligations. We would like to thank Steuben County for their cooperation through-out the lengthy process.

Energy Efficiency Rebates

Program Objectives

- > To continue the Cooperative's long history of promoting energy efficiency.
- Encourage members to upgrade old, inefficient appliances with a reduced cost burden.

Incentives Offered

- The Cooperative is offering a 20% rebate on Energy Star rated appliances, limited to: refrigerator, freezer, dishwasher, clothes washer/dryer, dehumidifier, window air conditioner, air source heat pumps and electric water heater.
- Limit: \$400 incentive per appliance.

Conditions

- Appliance must have been purchased after June 1, 2019.
- Appliance must be Energy Star rated.
- Members must complete the Energy Star rebate form located on the Cooperative's website and submit the completed application to the Cooperative's Bath District office by mail or in person.
- Attach a receipt showing the date of purchase.
- The old appliance must be removed from service and disposed in an environmentally responsible manner. The Cooperative may require proof of disposal prior to issuing the rebate.

FARM EFFICIENCY REBATES



Program Objectives

- To continue the Cooperative's long history of promoting energy efficiency with a reduced cost burden to our members.
- To support our local agriculture industry that is the backbone of our communities.

Incentives Offered

• The Cooperative is offering a 75% rebate up to \$4,500 on the installation and purchase of the following equipment: Energy Star Certified LED Lighting for Barns and Shops, Variable Speed Milk Transfer Pumps, Variable Speed Compressors, Tunnel Ventilation Construction and Precooling Systems and Heat Exchangers (Plate or Shell & Tube).

Other Conditions

- Equipment must have been purchased after June 1, 2019.
- Limited to \$4,500 per member per year (\$6,000 total investment).
- To be eligible for the rebate, proof of installation must be provided. The Cooperative reserves the right to physically inspect the installation.
- Members must complete the Farm Efficiency rebate form located on the Cooperative's website and submit the completed application to the Cooperative's Bath District office by mail or in person.
- Attach receipts showing the date of purchase and installation.
